  - PSAT TEST**: Help check in students and/or monitor students during test taking on a Saturday in October. [IHS]
  - AP EXAM**: Monitor students during AP exams. Four hours in May. [IHS]
- VOICE – Volunteers Of Issaquah Changing Education**: **VOICE** volunteers work in school as one-on-one mentors with students just one hour per week. Students are referred for need of a mentor by school teachers and counselors. **VOICE** volunteers are carefully matched with the student and become positive, dependable role models and another caring adult in the life of this student. **VOICE** mentors partner with schools staff to support students academically and socially. Mentors help foster social skills and motivate students' desire to be lifelong learners. One hour a week can make all the difference in the world to a struggling student. [Program is administered by the Issaquah Schools Foundation]
